STAFF

COORDINATING ACTIVITIES, RITES AND / OR CEREMONIES:

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, which may include but is not limited to: expert advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to disposition, drafting notices, advice regarding possible government benefits. Planning and scheduling of services, coordination of all rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as flowers and death notices, and outside facilities such as churches and halls.

Basic Services: \$700.00

Graveside and/or Funeral Home Service: \$900.00 Service at Alternate Location: \$1200.00

DOCUMENTATION – PERMITS, FORMS ETC.: Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, acquisition of a burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation. As part of this service, we will assist with CPP applications when appropriate, and provide you with an unlimited supply of death certificates. **Fee: \$300.00**

AT HOME ARRANGEMENTS: A licensed funeral director will attend an individual's residence or location mutually agreed upon in order to complete the funeral arrangements.

Fee: \$150.00 (within 10 km.) – *In addition to Coordinating Activities, Rites and/or Ceremonies*

AT HOME AFTERCARE: We offer thorough documentation for concluding the affairs of the estate. Proof of Death Certificates, government notifications and the provision of completed application forms for submission to Service Canada for the Canada Pension Plan Lump Sum Death Benefit (maximum \$2500 based on individual contributions). As well, we assist with the CPP Survivor's Benefits should it be applicable. A thorough checklist is provided so you have some direction regarding additional tasks that may need to be completed. All of this can be done at our office or in the comfort of your own home. **Fee: \$100.00** (within 10 km)

STAFF FOR TRANSFER OF RECIPIENT: Trained staff, available 24 hours a day to pick up deceased at location of place of death. **Fee: \$150.00**

AFTER HOURS TRANSFER: Trained staff available after 5pm on weekdays and weekends to transfer deceased from place of death to our facility. This fee is applicable after regular business hours. Fee: \$150.00 – In addition to Staff for Transfer of Recipient

BASIC HANDLING OF RECIPIENT: (Requires facilities for preparation /shelter/embalming) The preparation of the body for placement into the casket or cremation container, including any necessary cleansing, dressing and checking remains for personal effects. This charge applies whenever we handle remains. **Fee: \$100.00**

EMBALMING OF RECIPIENT: Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. **Fee: \$395.00** **REMOVAL OF PACEMAKERS:** The removal of a pacemaker will be carried out by a licensed professional.

Fee: \$75.00

STAFF FOR OPEN HOUSE IDENTIFICATION / VISITATION:

Professionally trained staff to coordinate and oversee greeting and directing visitors, provision of lounge services when on our premises, coordinating and overseeing identification / visitation. **Identification: \$100.00** (per half hour) **Visitation: \$200.00** (per hour)

STAFF FOR OPEN HOUSE IDENTIFICATION/VISITATION – AFTER

HOURS: Same as staff for Open House Identification for a period of one hour after regular business hours. (On weekends or after 5pm on weekdays). **Fee: \$200.00** (per hour)

STAFF FOR OPEN HOUSE REMEMBRANCE / CEREMONY:

Professionally trained staff to coordinate and oversee greeting and directing visitors, provision of lounge services when on our premises, coordinating and overseeing the ceremony, celebration of life or memorial service. **Fee: \$200.00**

STAFF FOR RECEPTION: Staff to coordinate and oversee the proper handling of reception duties. This may include but is not limited to greeting and serving beverages to guests. Includes coordination of reception set up, catering set-up and clean-up of facilities. **Fee: \$250.00**

SMART SERVE STAFF: Our smart serve graduates are trained to protect the public. Smart Serve trained individuals have learned the skills and knowledge to act decisively when over consumption occurs. They are required by law when alcohol is being served on our premises. Fee: \$250.00 **STAFF TO PLACE OF DISPOSITION:** Staff to coordinate and oversee the delivery of the deceased to a local cemetery or crematorium. To ensure that the families final wishes for interment are fulfilled appropriately staff will always be present regardless of family or clergy attendance. **Fee: \$200.00**

STAFF FOR SPRING INTERMENT: Staff to coordinate and execute the activities and duties involved in the entire process necessary for the Spring interment of the deceased. This may include, but is not limited to, additional preparation of documentation or permits, contacting the cemetery staff to arrange and coordinate the opening and closing of the grave, overseeing graveside committal service for casket or cremated remains, contacting clergy, vault company, flower orders, newspaper notices, pipers etc. **Fee: \$200.00**

PALL BEARERS: Our trained staff are available to assist families in need of pall bearers. They will carry or escort the casket from the funeral coach/vehicle to place of service and place of disposition. **Fee: \$75.00** (per pall bearer)

BASIC PHOTOGRAPHY SESSION: Assigned staff will take photographs as requested by the family. Includes USB. **Fee: \$150.00**

LOCAL DELIVERY OF CREMATED REMAINS: Staff will personally hand deliver cremated remains to your home, cemetery or location of your choice. **Fee: \$75.00** (within 10 km)

DELIVERY OF CREMATED REMAINS BY MAIL: Secure packaging and delivery of cremated remains to any location in North America. Additional fees may be required "at cost" for any other international delivery. **Fee: \$80.00**

EXPEDITED CREMATION SERVICES: Should there be a cause or need for expedited cremation services this fee will be charged as substantial time must be committed immediately in order to coordinate the documentation required, the coroner and the crematorium in order to meet expected timelines.

Fee: \$200.00

ADDITIONAL STAFF: This fee will be applied when additional staff are required due to large attendance at specified events, witnessing at the crematorium.

Fee: \$150.00

FACILITIES

FACILITIES BASIC USE: Use of our general and common areas, arrangement offices, public washroom, heating, electricity, lounge, main entrance, and all overhead charges involved in maintaining our facility. **Fee: \$0.00**

FACILITIES FOR PREPARATION / SHELTER: Facilities used to prepare, embalm, and / or shelter of the body. This charge applies whenever the body is in our facility for any purpose. **Fee: \$200.00**

FACILITIES FOR OPEN HOUSE IDENTIFICATION/VISITATION: Use of designated facilities for the purpose of identification or visitation. **Identification: \$100.00** (per half hour)

Visitation: \$200.00 (per hour)

FACILITIES FOR OPEN HOUSE REMEMBRANCE / CEREMONY:

Use of designated facilities for the purpose of a memorial service, celebration of life, gathering or ceremony.

Fee: \$200.00

FACILITIES FOR RECEPTION: (Requires Staff for reception, coordinating activities, rites and ceremonies and basic facility fees) Use of our reception lounge for a maximum of two hours, heating/ cooling, electricity, tables, chairs, refrigeration, dish washing equipment, dish ware, furniture, and all overhead charges in maintaining the lounge and facility.

Fee: \$250.00

FACILITIES FULL USE OF PUBLIC SPACE: The use of the entire public facility can be arranged for with sufficient advance notice. **Fee: \$450.00**

USE OF AUDIO-VISUAL EQUIPMENT: Equipment used in the recording or playback of requested services. Fee: \$125.00

VEHICLES

CLERGY/DIRECTOR/LEAD VEHICLE: If requested, vehicle used to pick up and/or transport clergy and/or funeral director to ceremony or final place of disposition.

Fee: \$225.00

FUNERAL COACH: Specialized vehicle used in procession to final place of disposition. **Fee: At Cost** **TRANSFER VEHICLE FOR INITIAL TRANSFER** (within 10 km): Custom vehicle and specialized equipment used to transfer deceased into our care from place of death.

Fee: \$150.00 (within 10 km)

VEHICLE TO CEREMONY AND / OR DISPOSITION: Vehicle used to transport the deceased's body or cremated remains to location of ceremony and/or disposition. Fee: \$150.00 (within 10 km)

LIMOUSINE: Limousine or Minibus and driver to transport family on the day of the funeral.

Fee: At Cost

VEHICLE FOR SPRING INTERMENT: General duty vehicle and specialized equipment used to transfer the deceased from the seasonal holding facility to the place of interment. The funeral coach may be substituted at the request of the family.

Fee: \$225.00

MILEAGE PER KILOMETRE: Charge per kilometre (one way) for use of any vehicle over and above a 10 km radius included in the initial vehicle fee.

Fee: \$2.25 per km/one way.

VEHICLE FOR CARRY OUT: Our van will be used to transport the deceased's body or cremated remains to location of final disposition in the presence of the family and / pall bearers. **Fee: \$225.00** (within 10 km)

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the funeral home. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. If disbursements are on our contract, they may be subject to HST. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements:

CORONER'S FEE: This is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

MUNICIPAL DEATH REGISTRATION FEE: This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

CLERGY/CELEBRANT OFFERING: This is an amount of money paid to the clergy/church/celebrant/organist for their services. In many instances, it is set by the providers and in other cases it is an amount you wish to offer.

NEWSPAPER NOTICES: These are charges for death notices placed into media. Prices are set out by the companies.

FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS: This fee is based on the floral selections by the family when utilizing our recommended florist.
